# A Message From Charlie Sikora Financial Secretary/Treasurer



Vacation picking at all locations will be upon you soon. And with that, you will soon be receiving a vacation option form. These forms, as with respect to your birthday can be used as a banked sick day, a floating holiday or get an extra day pay on that day. With your date of hire option, you can use as a bank sick day or get an extra day pay on that day also. With Good Friday, you can use as a banked sick day, but only after Good Friday on April, 10, 2020 or get an extra day pay on Good Friday. Whatever option you chose, it is very important that you familiarize yourself with (Section 18.5) of the contract before you use any of these days so you don't end up loosing a days pay or getting a miss.

The other form is for employees with twentyseven years or more and for employees with at least five or more remaining 2019 sick/personal days, which can be used as an extra week of vacation or five single vacation days for 2020. The company uses this form to set the vacation quotas for 2020. Please refer to Section (12-33-C) of the contract so you don't have a problem using your single vacation days if you chose that option.

As a clerk for thirty years doing vacations at Cold Spring and Frontier Stations, I've seen every possible employee mistake that forced management to pick their vacation for them. Don't let this happen to you. If management has to pick your 2020 vacation, they will give you the closest to what you picked for 2019. If you are getting an extra week vacation next year compared to this year, they will ether go by your picking pattern if there is one, or throw it in any week they want.

Soon there will be a list posted at the locations showing every employee by seniority with the date, time, and number of weeks he or she is picking. Also posted are the quotas which shows how many employees the company is allowing to be on vacation for any given week. About five days before you pick, the clerk will give you a form that shows the day, time, and number of weeks you will be picking. Make sure the number of weeks on that form matches the one that will be posted. If you are going on vacation, ask the clerk for your vacation form early or make arrangements with the person doing the vacation picking so you can pick over the telephone. If you can't be present for any reason, make sure you leave your choice sheet with the clerk and with enough choices in case the week or weeks you want are gone.
