Important ATU Local 1342 Election Information

The ballots will be mailed out from Pittsburgh, PA on November 12th. If you don't receive your ballot by November 20, 2019, contact MK Election Services, LLC at 1-209-259-6740 or call the Union Office at 825-9217 to verify your address and re-

quest another ballot be mailed.

When you receive your ballot, fill in the box completely with any dark colored pen. A check mark may carry into another box and void your ballot. And only vote for the number of candidates permitted for each office.

Place the SECRET BALLOT ENVELOPE into

the return envelope which contains your voter information and no postage is necessary. Your personal information cannot be linked to your ballot.

NO Hand-delivered ballots will be accepted. All ballots must be at the post office prior to pick up by MK Election Services on Thursday, December 12th, 2019 or they will not be counted.

Important Information Regarding Benefits

Notice of Qualifying Events and Benefit Changes

Life Event Changes — Benefit plans can be affected by life event changes, some of which qualify as an official change in status by the IRS. Generally, when you enroll in benefits as a new employee, you cannot make changes until the next Open Enrollment period. However, if you experience a qualified change in status, you can make mid-year changes.

What is a Life Event? - A life event change, also called a qualifying event, is a personal change in status which may allow you to change your benefit elections. A life event is as follows:

Marriage, Divorce*, Birth or Adoption,

Loss of Other Health Coverage, Spouse Begins or Ends Employment.

*When an employee is divorced, the ex-spouse is no longer eligible for health care coverage as a dependent spouse. Employees must submit a change of event notice within 31 calendar days of the divorce to remove their former spouse. The employee continuing coverage for a former spouse on the plan is considered insurance fraud.

If you experience a qualifying event, you will need to request a change to your benefits within 31 calendar days of the event and provide required documentation. If you do not request the change within 31 calendar days, the next opportunity you will have to make the changes to your benefits will be during the annual open enrollment.
