I was asked recently by some of our members about requirements for discipline. An employer must prove six elements to justify an insubordination charge:

1) The supervisor directive was clear, understandable, and firm, making the employee aware that he or she had no choice in the matter.

2) The order served the needs of the business. An order concerning non workrelated activity or a manager's personal needs does not provide proper grounds for an insubordination charge.

3) The employee knew that the person giving the order had authority to issue directions.

4) The supervisor gave the employee a warning of the consequences.

5) The employee's refusal was knowing, willful and deliberate.

6) The employee was given an opportunity to correct.

A Message From Charlie Sikora Financial Secretary/Treasurer

First, I'd like to wish everyone a safe Christmas, Kwanzaa, and Hanukkah.

This will be my last newsletter as I will be finishing up my second and last term as your Financial Secretary/Treasurer on December 31st and retiring after 33 years.

I was hired on January 14, 1987 as a Porter, which also was my birthday. After spending three months cleaning rail stations, I bid on a bus driving position and worked out of the Cold Spring Station. While there, I became an Extra Station Clerk and was trained by Jim Grabowski, Barbara Thomas, and the late Edward Garwol, the Station Clerks at that time. I then became the full time Clerk on February 1, 1990 when Grabowski Jim accepted what was then called the Station Supervisor position. I transferred to the Frontier Station as a Clerk in 1998 when Michael Cavarello passed away.

Around 2003, I was elected on the Board of Directors of the N.F.T.A. Employees Federal Credit Union, which merged with the GM Employee's Credit Union called the Riverside Credit Union, and still hold that position until I can find someone in this union and a member to replace me.

In 2010, I ran for office to finish an open term and was elected Financial Secretary/Treasurer, taking office on June 1, 2010. I then ran for a full threeyear term and was elected again taking office January 1, 2011. I went back to the Frontier Station as a Clerk at the end of that term after a close election. When Kathy Ehrig retired at the end of her term, I ran and was



elected to another threeyear term starting January 1, 2017.

I have enjoyed my time in office and performed to the best of my ability in every position that I held at Metro and with the Union, and feel I've lived up to the tag line that I put on my first campaign poster back in 2010, "Honesty and Integrity"

Ron Giza will be taking over as your next Financial Secretary/Treasurer, as he is running unopposed in this election. I will obviously be staying on for a short time to train him and I'm sure he will do a great job. I still plan on attending the monthly Union meetings and will be seeing a lot of you there.
