The most valuable asset you can possess on your job at Metro is your drivers license. Your job is conditioned upon you having a valid CDL license. Safeguard your license by any means necessary and at all cost. Do not jeopardize or compromise vour license. A suspended or revoked license is your worst enemy. Without your license, you may find yourself without a job. Take the time needed to always renew your license in a timely manner. You can renew your license up to one year prior to the date of expiration.

On Monday, January 6, 2020, the City of Buffalo activated 14 of 20 cameras in school zones. The speed limit in a school zone is 15 MPH. Please watch your speed. If you are issued a ticket, you will be responsible for the \$50 fine.

If you are off on a leave, please read Section 8 - "Leaves of Absence" in your contract book, especially Section 8-5.3 "Engaging in other Employment While on Leave"- An employee who during the period of any leave of absence shall not engage in any occupation or employment, except with the mutual consent of the company and the union, shall be considered as voluntarily quit the employment of the company". Please take time to read your contract and all other materials passed out by the company or union.

If you do not have a contract, please contact your union official.

Now that the election is over, please get to know your union Stewards and Executive Board members. I believe we have a great group of men and women who took an oath to serve the membership and to protect your rights within the cba. As President, I promise to fight for each and every one of our union members.




9217) or me (444-4340). If I don't have the answer, I will help you find it.
