Brothers and Sisters,

In the month of July, assaults at NFTA Metro have increased. Our ATU Brothers and Sisters continue to call the union office as well as my cell phone regarding various assaults against operators. You must report all assaults so these individuals can be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law.

Governor Cuomo's new legislation clarifies existing protections for transportation workers while adding new ones. Any form of forceful or violent physical contact against a worker on duty, including spitting on them, constitutes a Class -A Misdemeanor, punishable up to one year in prison.

The vast majority of assaults against transit workers are not fatal. Eighty-One percent (81%) of assaults against bus operators are verbal, sixty percent (60%) involve spitting at the worker, while two percent (2%) involve a weapon. Further, the most common assaults against transit workers are under reported.

I believe the Coronavirus Pandemic appears to have exacerbated the risk of assaults for transit operators, especially when it comes to enforcing mask mandates. Metro has made mask wearing a requirement for all riders, and while riders often comply, others don't, and those trying to enforce such mandates have faced conse-

quences.

Here are a couple reminders if your employee number has been called for random drug testing. Proceed directly to the tester. DO NOT stop at the restroom, DO NOT stop and converse with other employees, DO NOT go to your locker. Any of these actions may result in a positive result.

All union members, please stay off your cell phone unless you are on a break. You cannot even display your phone.

I'm happy to announce that we were able to settle some potential grievances without going to arbitration,

which included members receiving back pay. We also saved members jobs that were facing termination.

Last but not least is mental health in the workplace. I never really understood the importance of dealing with union members facing so many challenges until I became union president. Here are some depression symptoms: Feeling very down or sad * Feeling worried and empty * Sleeping too much or too little * Feeling tired or slowed down * Changes in appetite or weight * Having little or no interest or pleasure in your hobbies * Having trouble concentrating * Thinking about death or suicide *

Feeling like you can't enjoy anything * Forgetting things a lot * Having trouble sleeping.
